

Quantitative/MATH Test Acing Tips

- Repetition – complete as many practice problems as possible.
- Challenge yourself : take time to practice difficult problems.
- Try to get through problems by yourself first before seeking assistance. As human brain struggles to understand, it gains greater ability to understand. Give it some time, but don't sit on it for too long.
- Focus on understanding the principles - as opposed to just getting the answer right! Math is cumulative!
- Make a list of important formulas/concepts.
- Use study groups to discuss concepts and problem solving.
- Read the whole question carefully.
- Show your work.
- Don't erase confusing problems – you may be able to earn partial credit based on the nature of the exam.
- Review your answers. It may help you catch an error.
